






2. Note the position of the handle, handle stop, and stem orientation. The handle *must* be reassembled in the same position. NOTICE

Do not cycle the valve with handle unattached.

- Remove the handle screw and handle. Set aside for later reassembly.
- Decide upon either front or back mounting of the valve. Refer to Fig. 2a and 2b.
- Place the mounting bracket over the valve in the desired position. Refer to Fig. 2a or 2b.
- Drill holes in panel. Refer to Fig. 3.
- Place valve/bracket assembly in position.
- Reassemble handle onto valve in same position as before disassembly.
- Insert handle screw and torque to 1 in.-lbs. (0.11 N·m)
- 10. Snap handle insert back into handle.







